

Greenhouse Gas Emissions

n December, 195 nations pledged to work to reduce the greenhouse gas emissions that most scientists agree are contributing to global warming. The graph at right shows which countries have the most work to do. These 10 nations are responsible for more than half of the global total of 47,500 million metric tons of greenhouse gas emissions. The lineup is hardly surprising, however. All of these nations rank among the world's 20 largest economies; one major source of emissions is the burning of fossil fuels by various industries.

The bar graph below shows the 10 countries with the most greenhouse gas emissions.
